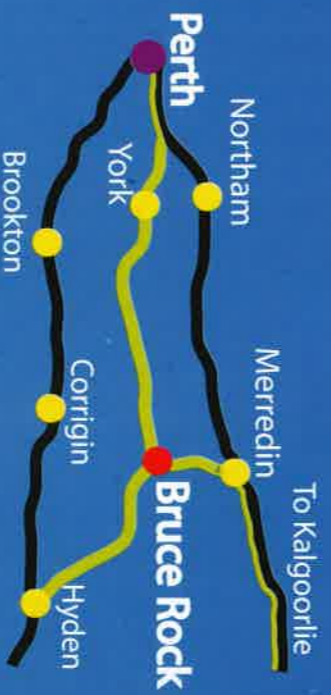

# Bruce Rock Memorial Aquatic Centre

## Bruce Rock Federation Amphitheatre and Sculpture Park

Nights at the Bruce Rock Amphitheatre under the stars watching a theatrical performance are a delightful way to spend an evening.

This unique venue is based on a true amphitheatre with an excellent stage, sound and lighting facilities.

The amphitheatre is the venue for a wide variety of cultural shows and entertainment and can be hired for weddings, seminars and gatherings during the year, or used as a pleasant travellers stop.

# Kokerbin Rock

Reputed to be the third largest monolith in Australia, Kokerbin Rock is an interesting unspoilt spot for flora and fauna study, and also for picnics.

It covers 9 hectares and is 122m high with interesting formations, caves and an historical deep well on the western side.

It is situated approximately 40kms north west of Bruce Rock. (Map ref: C2)



Another terrific natural bushland and picnic spot is Bruce's Rock (Map ref: C6).

The Bruce Rock Caravan Park, with backpacker facilities, has a well equipped campers kitchen, with full ovens so that you can cook that longed for roast. Bruce Rock is a RV friendly town.



The Ardath Hotel is 21km from Bruce Rock. Your party can be catered for here, so enjoy good food and a friendly atmosphere, while admiring the fully restored building.

The Bruce Rock Roadhouse, open 7 days a week, provides dine in and takeaway meals, fuel and accommodation, and sells sports memorabilia.

The friendly management at Bruce Rock Hotel provides counter lunches, an evening menu and accommodation.
